Variable Intensity and Exposure on Windows

RoscoVIEW Panels

RoscoVIEW panels are finding wide acceptance in the television and motion picture industries.

A two-part system, RoscoVIEW is placed on the windows and a RoscoVIEW camera filter is fitted to the camera lens. By rotating the camera filter when shooting towards the windows, cross polarization occurs. This effectively lets you change the exposure outside the windows to match the interior exposure. It is quite possible to be 10 stops overexposed outside and dial that overexposure down. As the exterior exposure changes, you can instantly make corrections by simply rotating the camera filter.

All this happens for the camera sensor only. To the naked eye there are no changes except for a reduction of one stop of light entering the windows.
